A curtain made of soft fabric that can be shaped any kind of way.

Thanks to the integrated facet structure, with the gold-plated block magnets (www.supermagnete.de/eng/Q-10-05-02-G) it keeps its form when you push it up, to the side or when you pull it back down again.
