

Application No. 210: Nail rake

How to protect yourself from rusty nails on the ground when barefoot

After the roofing work, many nails remained undiscovered in the gravel around the house. This is not particularly healthy for running around bare-foot...

We had the idea of fixing 15 blocks Q-15-15-08-N (www.supermagnete.de/eng/Q-15-15-08-N) with adhesive tape on flat brass (about 30 cm long) at intervals of approx. 3 cm. You need two people for that, because the blocks gravitate towards each other heavily! To protect the magnets, we covered the whole brass bar with tear-proof adhesive tape.



Then, we attached the wrapped bar to a short-haired broom with some adhesive tape. Thereafter, we patiently pulled the broom over the gravel, lane by lane.



The result was astounding: We "harvested" a total of 1,5 kg rusty nails that were not visible to the naked eye before.
