You can defuse our magnets a little bit with felt...



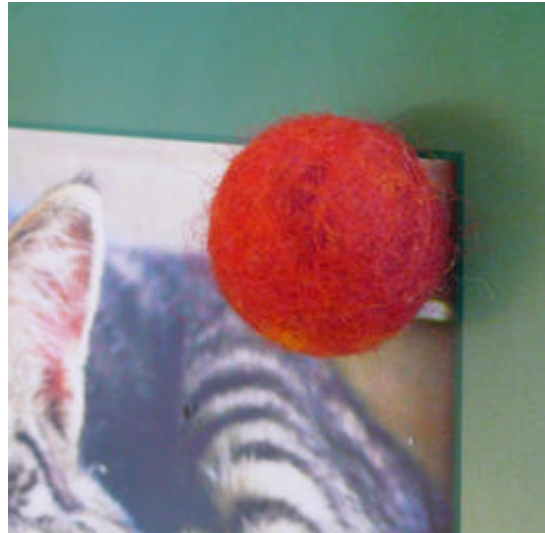

The felt protects the refrigerator from hard contact with magnet and even looks good. Since each felt magnet is handmade, each has a unique size and color.
